Red Sox Raffle: Lynn Goodman provided an update on ticket sales. Approximately \$200 per venue is being collected; ticket sales continue. The members discussed how to market this for next year, and what changes to make.

<u>Doll Clothes Sale:</u> This is ready to go; additional volunteers would be helpful. This will probably be the last sale of this type.

<u>Lighting the new sign:</u> When Amanda returns to work, Parsons Electric will meet with her to finalize the decisions for additional lighting on the new sign.

New Business:
