SPRING BOOK SALE, JUNE 6-9, 2018

The semi-annual Friends' book sale is coming right up, so be sure to mark your calendars so you won't miss it. We'll have thousands of books, including fiction, children's, history, war, politics, biography, cook books, gardening, science, animals, sports, poetry, classics, humor, health, art, crafts, home, self-help, religion/inspiration, local interest, romance, miscellaneous; and books, music, and movies on CDs and DVDs. Most hard cover books are \$1, and paperbacks 50 cents. Most children's books are 25 cents. There is also a table of books priced at \$2 and up.

Only Friends members may attend on Wednesday evening and get first pick. You may join or renew at the door.

Thursday, June 7: 9 a.m.-7 p.m.

Friday, June 8: 9 a.m.- 4 p.m.

Saturday, June 9: 9 a.m.- noon. Final hours of book sale. Saturday Only = Tote bag day (buy a bag, fill for free)
On Saturday only, you may purchase a Friends tote bag for \$6 at the door and fill it once for free. (Offer only valid for bags purchased Saturday morning). Or purchase anything without buying a bag.

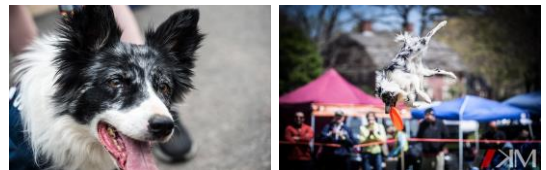
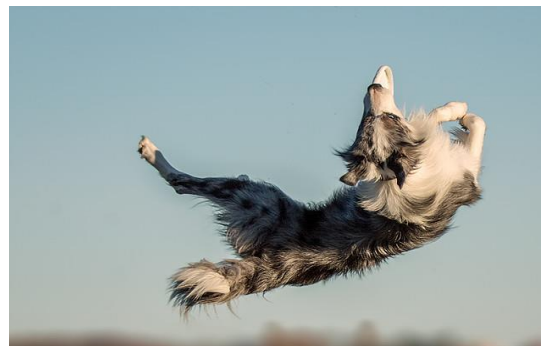
